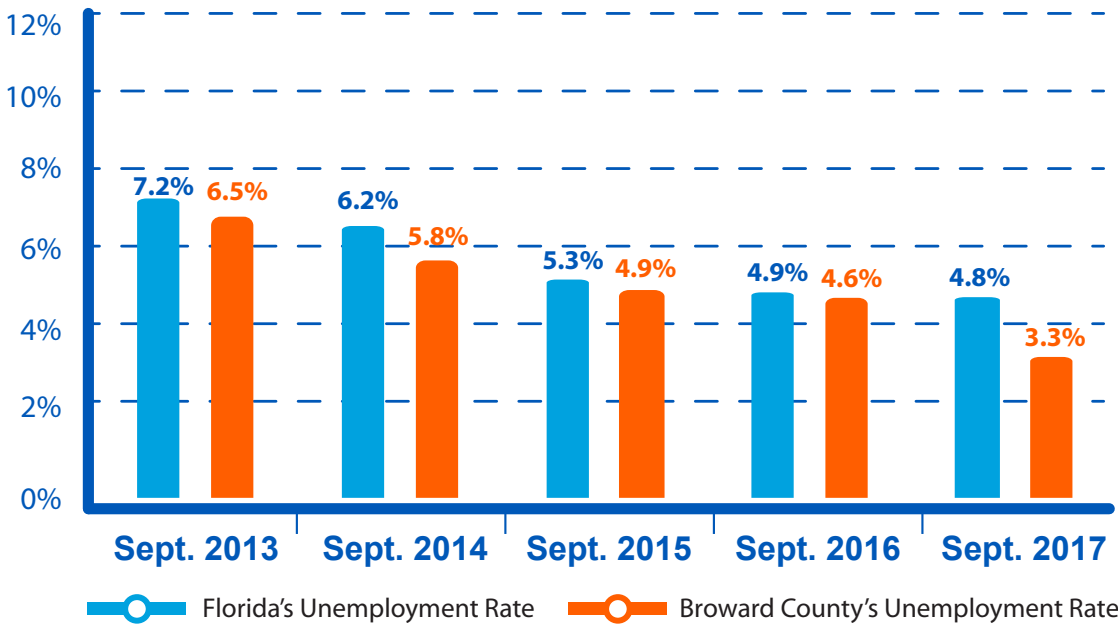


Broward County's Labor Market Unemployment Rate
